Dear Ms Boyden,

Thanks for your letter dated from the 24th of November.

We expect the official proclamation on the Hungarian veterinarians who can be seen on the video and on those who are presumably take part in the frauds, and on exact place and time of the recordings from Defra.

Maybe a part of my previous letter was mistakeable. We do not intend to land your helpers and the video makers into difficulty.

The basis principle in Hungary is that everybody is innocent until his/her guiltiness is not proven on a non-apellable way.

I'm sure that both Hungarian Police and the State Veterinary Authority will by all means need the videos in a form where faces of the Hungarian veterinarians can be seen (so that they can be undoubtedly identified), and their words can be heard. If a video cannot be used as evidence, it cannot be utilized in an official procedure.

Suppose, that the conversation with the Hungarian veterinarians was much longer than it was published in the short video. During the reports/converstions a lot of statements could be recorded that can be accepted by the Hungarian authorities as evidence on participation of the Hungarian vets in the fraud.

Therefore we kindly ask you again to pass the unedited version of the video made about the Hungarian veterinarians either to us, or to the Hungarian State Veterinary Authorities.
